TESYouth (Training, Employment Opportunities & Social Development for Young People) as a Social Enterprise, NFP and voluntary organisation was set up in June 2013 with the aim to tackle and reduce youth unemployment by equipping and empowering young people.



About TESYouth

TESYouth has a particular focus on young people aged 18 to 25 in London who are disadvantaged or unemployed, specifically those who are NEET (Not in Education, Employment or Training), and those with few skills and qualifications.

We are dedicated to make a big difference in society.

Our mission is to reduce the number of young people out of work by providing them with the necessary tools to develop skills, aptitudes, knowledge and self-confidence through workshops, mentoring and work experience so the participants might overcome the barriers they face in obtaining secure employment or self-employment.

Our goal is to remove the obstacles blocking young people from utilising their skills and talents and to encourage them to participate positively in their communities.

TESYouth's board consists of directors and board members who collectively have close to 120 years of experience.

Our success to date (June 2016)

- From 25 attendees in our work experience programmes (18 to 25 year olds), 80% continued with further education, 10% started own business, 20% secured a job and 20% got apprenticeships
- We have provided and offered workshops to about 200, 16 to 25 year olds in various locations in London



Feedback
